Shut down tips CNC Machine

Dear Customer,

Please read through our handy hints to help you with your CNC Machining Centre start-up following extended shutdown periods, such as the upcoming holiday season.

Before shutdown:

- 1. Remove tools from the spindle on Machining Centres and wipe inside the spindle taper.
- 2. On Turning Centres to remove the material from the chuck whilst the machine is off.
- 3. Make sure all machine surfaces are free from coolant to avoid rust; a light layer of oil can be very useful.
- 4. Make sure all major and minor problems are reported as to avoid bigger problems in the New Year. Sometimes a small problem compounds and becomes a very massive expensive issue.
- 5. Make sure if you haven't replaced batteries in the last year, to do this. (Always while the power is on) We do this for our customers upon request.
- 6. It's always advisable to do a full machine back up every year. We do this for our customers upon request.
- 7. Make sure all oil and lubricants are topped up

Starting up:

- 1. Always start up the machine doing a long spindle warm up, at a low speed for at least 45min to an hour.
- 2. Check for any Alarms upon start up. Please note these down.
- 3. Check all oils and lubricants are topped up.
- 4. It's always advised to run a warmup program for at least one hour before running full production.
